He has asked me to let you know that he has once again written on your behalf to the Minister of State for Defence Procurement, Jeremy Quinn MP, to bring your allegations and concerns to his attention. He has also included Cllr Manning's and Cllr Randall's comments, and I shall let you know as soon as Michael has a response.

Michael has spoken to Councillors about the [proposed changes to the byelaws](#) affecting MoD land, and had an online meeting Cllr Paul Deach and Cllr Attieh Fard in late February. Furthermore, he has raised this with other nearby MPs who also have MoD land in their constituencies, and I understand that a joint meeting with the Secretary of State for Defence is due to take place in several weeks' time.
